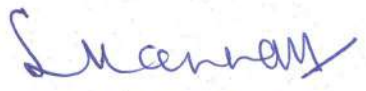
### Recommendations of the Expert Committee:

Out of four faculties, two senior members alone hold Ph.D. degrees. The remaining two junior faculties are to be instructed to get their Ph.D. degree at the earliest possible.

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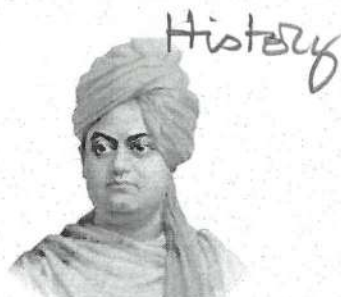
